

Take off with the family for the day with a Daytripper ticket. With unlimited travel for one day by rail, Subway, most buses throughout Strathclyde and some ferries, the savings are enormous!

**£17.50** 2 adults and up to 4 children (5 to 15 years inc.)  
**£9.80** 1 adult and up to 2 children (5 to 15 years inc.)

Daytripper tickets are valid after 9.00am Monday to Friday and all day at weekends and Glasgow public holidays. Tickets can be bought from any staffed rail station, SPT travel centre or online at [www.spt.co.uk](http://www.spt.co.uk)

**NB** Daytripper tickets cannot be bought from ticket issuing staff on board rail or bus services.

**How it works**

On your chosen day, simply rub off the year, month, date and day when you start your first journey, then seal down the plastic cover or your ticket will not be valid.

There's nothing more to pay for any number of journeys for the rest of the day. Use your Daytripper ticket the day you buy it, or save it and travel on another day – it's valid for the remaining years indicated.
