

Journey Planner in a Box

Add our powerful public transport journey planner to your website - for free! This tool will allow your website visitors to plan their journey to your premises quickly and easily.

What does it do?

Available as an easy-to-install widget, Journey Planner in a Box can be added to any third party website. It is fully customisable and allows you to provide visitors with tailored public transport information. It allows you to offer seamless integration with the Traveline Scotland journey planner.

Who uses it?

It is useful for businesses, hotels, visitor attractions, universities, conference venues, public buildings... Any location staff or visitors may want to travel to!

How does it work?

Visitors on your website see one of six possible journey planner templates. See some examples on the right.

They enter their location details, select date and time of travel (if applicable), and search for their journey.

Journeys results are displayed in a new window so visitors never have to navigate away from your website to find their journey.

How do you install it?

Journey Planner in a Box can be easily added to your website by adding some HTML code which is generated specifically for your location:


- Visit www.travelinescotland.com
- Click on “Download Free Journey Planner”
- Select which type of planner you would like to use:
 - Fixed to plan directly to your location, or plan between any two points
- Choose which template you would like:
 - Travel now (user only enters their starting location)
 - More options (user can select date and time of travel)
- Copy and paste the generated HTML code into your website.

How much does it cost?

Journey Planner in a Box is **FREE** to all end users.

What if you want to customise the journey planner further?

Some organisations, like Homecoming Scotland and Strathclyde Partnership for Transport have customised the journey planner to the style of their websites:


